Please pray for all the obvious needs: consolation, safety, travel, but especially that our Lord would show a way for Christian to be healed. Please pray that the insurance will assist them. My wife was able to see Christian recently (she went to Wisconsin for her mother's 90th birthday), but all I have are pictures. Thank you! Cortright - Eurasia

9. Pray for strength and just plain, old pluck: we are moving to Russia very soon and it will be very different! We are working on learning Russian to be able to negotiate basic life situations and it is a big task: Мы изучаем русский язык, но он медленный! (= We are learning Russian, but it is not easy!) Please pray for our transition and adjustment as we go. I will be teaching at a seminary and ask that God would use me to help equip the students to preach the Gospel of our Lord to the Russian people. Cortright - Eurasia

Our Executive Director for Rebuilding the Breach Ministries, Inc. has been working without pay for two months now.
