With so many languages comes an ongoing need for translation of hymns, liturgy, and other worship resources. The purpose of this project is to offer training in the specific skills needed to write and translate hymns. Presentations will focus on Lutheran theology, translating, music, and poetry. This is intended for seminary instructors and church leaders, who in turn will train students as they translate and establish worship practices for their rural churches. Provisions are made for travel and attendance to the triennial Hymn Writer-Translators Conference in November 2019 at the LCMS seminary in Ft Wayne, Indiana.
