The Lutheran churches in Africa continue to grow and mature alongside their communities that are also in times of transition. Multi-generational churches, improved education, and urbanization push the Lutheran

church to guide and meet the changing needs and mentalities of their members. In order to remain faithful, competitive, and engaged in the changing times, while appreciating the value of local culture and communities, local seminaries require faculty with higher levels of education and advanced degrees. This project intends to provide scholarships to francophone theologians and pastors for advanced theological education in secular or religious schools in francophone Africa. Pastors who are graduates of the CLET or a sister confessional Lutheran institution, have been ordained for at least three years, and have demonstrated pastoral care and faithfulness to Lutheran doctrine, may apply to pursue accredited bachelors, masters or doctoral programs. Another scholarship is open to any vicar or pastor in francophone Africa to pursue accredited programs or certificates in biblical, theological, or local language formation.
