### **Thursday English Conversation Group**

Since the lockdown is affecting many things around the world; including travel and volunteer mission teams, our short-term coordinators and volunteer coordinators created an online English conversation partner project. We are pairing native English-speaking volunteers (from the United States) with students in Puerto Rico desiring to practice their English. The program is a 5-week commitment. I work alongside Ruth Maita, a fellow missionary serving in PR, to lead these English conversations via Zoom. It has gone exceedingly well! I may not be working with short term teams like a I thought I would be but, I still get to help connect those who are interested in serving with the mission field.

Weekly, we have forty-two students enrolled between the cities of Ponce and Mayagüez with

another 15 people on the waiting list, eager for future rounds. There are two groups of students and volunteers, one session on Tuesday and one on Thursday. Each week Ruth and I write conversation starters that we send to both the students and the volunteers. These "conversation starters" are usually questions about the bible story we read during the session. While I may be in the DR, I am excited to have begun my work "in" Puerto Rico with the Puerto Rican Mission. Moving to Puerto Rico will come in God's timing! I am thankful for technology that allows me to serve there virtually.

In addition to working with our online English classes, I am now in front of writing our Puerto Rico FORO Newsletter. (Stay tuned for more updates!)
