UPDATES FROM THE FIELD:

As the New Year begins, we embark on a new journey. Our missionaries in Africa remain faithful in walking alongside our partners in mission as we explore new and different ways of doing ministry. The seminaries in Ethiopia, Ghana, and Kenya have opened and are off to a good start; the church in Malawi is constructing a new church. Despite the on-going challenges of covid-19, the focus remains on sharing the Gospel, strengthening relationships, and building the church.

All of the schools in Kenya reopened at the start of the New Year. I visited Karama Academy Kibera with my colleague Britt Odemba, who serves as an education consultant. It was a joy to see all of the smiles and hear the laughter. The children and teachers are delighted to be back at school. There are many challenges as classes resume. The teachers are doing a lot of revision to get the students caught up and back on track. They are well on their way.

The Project 24 sites have reopened, and all of the children are back together. Various activities took place to help reintegrate the children. At Tumaini, local medical providers did medical check-ups to ensure the children were in good health; the children from Othoro did counseling and debriefing. The sites have taken great care to welcome the children back and get them back to regular routines.
