In many parts of Africa, those who are detained or serving prison sentences are given only meager food rations. The responsibility to provide the needed sustenance falls mainly on the prisoners' families and friends. The situation for hospital patients is the same– the family and friends of admitted patients must bring food. Oftentimes, family members and friends travel to the regional prison and hospital at great personal expense – leaving very little to actually give upon arrival. In Guinea in western Africa, pastors and members of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Guinea-Conakry make pastoral care and evangelism visits to prisons and hospitals to encourage by prayer and material charity. This project aims to provide the national church with additional clothes, clean rice, soap, bibles, and other necessities for distribution by pastors and lay leaders 3 times per month during such visits. Please pray for and consider walking alongside the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Guinea to serve both physical and spiritual needs of those in prisons and hospitals and their families who need the love of the body of Christ in their time of suffering.
