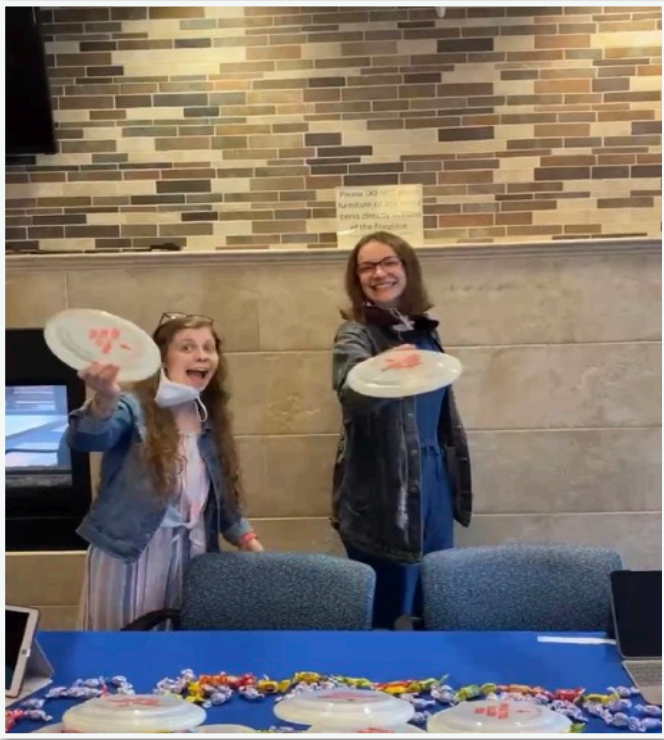
“A missionary is someone who tells other people about Jesus”, a kindergartener said proudly. This was the beginning of what I shared with the students at Trinity Lutheran School in Atchison, Kansas. We discussed sharing Jesus with our friends, living in another country, and learning a new language.

This fall on my home service I have ten school chapels on my schedule. Getting kids excited about missions helps the next generation of missionaries and missionary supporters begin to see how they can be a part of God's mission.

At the close, I reminded the students that when they share Jesus in their own communities, they are missionaries too! One student shouted, “I could tell my friend about Jesus, Miss Chelsea!” What a joyful and blessed end to the conversation.

When I moved to Český Těšín, Czech Republic, I had an extra bedroom in my apartment. I began to pray that if it was God's will, another missionary would be sent to serve in the Czech Republic. Six months later Hayden Rensner, a student at Concordia University, NE was accepted by the Board of International Mission in St. Louis to serve in the Czech Republic.

God changed Hayden's plans a lot! I cannot wait to see how He continues answering prayers and revealing His plan as we serve alongside each other in the Czech Republic.

When I arrived back in the United States I spent a week at the LCMS International Center in St. Louis, MO. It was a blessing to be in fellowship with other missionary colleagues. There we had the privilege of going through *Doxology*, a Nonprofit Registered Service Organization (RSO) with the LCMS who provide care and counsel to LCMS church workers. Learning, resting, and conversing with the Doxology staff was a tremendous help in reflecting on the ways in which God is working through me on the field.
