Regional Roundup: Peru

Sunday, September 18, marked a milestone in the life of *La Misión Luterana del Perú*: its first national assembly. The faithful from all three congregations came together in La Victoria for a day of fellowship beginning with worship.

The Rev. James Sharp, Area Facilitator, presided over Divine Service, including a rite of dedication for Peru's hot-off-the-press copies of *Himnario Luterano*. Several orders of business followed, chief among them a study of the biblical basis for calling men into the Holy Ministry and the issuing of a call to Candidate Jeancarlos Ramírez (center, in maroon) as pastor in La Victoria/chaplain of Castillo Fuerte. Also on the agenda: a presentation about Concordia the Reformer Seminary's diaconal formation program by Deac. Caitlin Ramírez. Peru is one of three countries set to enroll its first cohort of students. The La Victoria congregation fed everyone to conclude a historic day. Please pray for Jeancarlos and his family as he prayerfully deliberates, and for those women in Peru who may be considering diaconal ministry.
