Have a Blessed Summer!

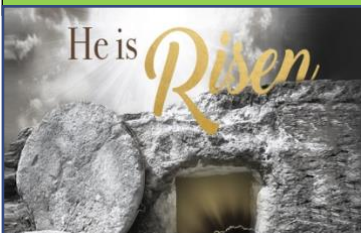

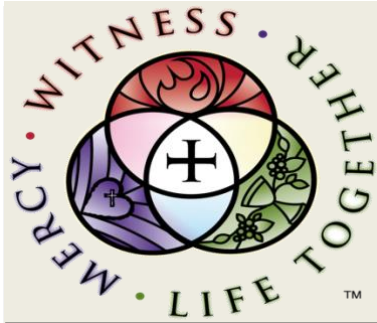
