He is currently working on a Doctor of Ministry degree from CTSFW. While at Risen Savior, he also volunteered as a police chaplain. In his free time, Jonah enjoys spending time with family, woodworking, cooking, reading, biking and drinking good coffee.

Renee is from Rapid City, S.D. She has held several jobs over the years, including bank teller and preschool assistant, but her most important role has been taking care of the couple’s five children: Gabriel, Isabella, Abigail, Isaiah and Phoebe. She also volunteered at Risen Savior as a Sunday school teacher and vacation Bible school leader. In her free time, Renee enjoys spending time with family, reading, photography, baking and teaching her children how to cook.
